HCBS = Home and Community Based Services Waiver (age 5 and up.) A converted score of 35 or greater is needed on the annual screening instrument called “BASIS.” Recipients of HCBS must also be eligible Medicaid beneficiaries.

MR/DD = Mental Retardation/Developmental Disability

SGF = State General Funds

Other = May include school district funding (for persons age 18 – 21 who have not yet graduated); Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) funding; charitable foundations; other funding not listed

*Targeted Case Management is required for any individual who accesses a paid service.

**Available funding for SGF Respite, Direct Financial Support and One-Time Payments is subject to change annually. Individuals must re-apply every year and may apply for all three services: SGF Respite; Direct Financial support; and, One-Time Payment. Eligibility and income restrictions apply.

At the present time, persons should expect to be wait-listed for HCBS and/or SGF services.
